

Please contact any member of the Nominating Committee (Kris Volpatti, Chuck Conn, Cheryl Banner, and Brendon Jenkins) or Pastor if you wish to be on the nominee slate. Last day to submit your name is November 14th.

MARK YOUR CALENDARS

The election will be held <u>Sunday</u>, <u>November 21st</u> immediately following Worship Services. The purpose of this meeting is for the election of Congregational Council for 2022. <u>Nominations shall not be taken from the floor during the meeting of the election.</u>



Congregation Meeting - A meeting of the Voting Membership of Bethany Lutheran Church will be held immediately following the 10:30 AM worship service on Sunday, November 21, 2021. One item has been placed on the agenda by the Congregation Council for discussion and vote:

- 1. The election of five (5) members to the Congregation Council (Term: 2022 2023). Per the <u>Bethany Constitution</u> Section C13.02.02:
- d. The list of candidates shall be submitted for publication in the various media of this congregation and shall be delivered by mail or electronic means, as permitted by state law, to all voting members at least 30 days prior to the meeting at which elections will take place.
- e. Following publication of the Nominating Committee's list, any voting member of this congregation may submit additional names to the Committee for inclusion on the list by letter or electronic means, as permitted by state law. These names shall be placed in nomination by the Committee along with the candidates already chosen, provided:
 - 1. that such names have been submitted at least 14 days prior to the election, and
 - 2. that the Nominating Committee shall have investigated the status of the proposed candidates and found them eligible for office and willing to serve. No qualified candidate may be omitted.
- f. The Nominating Committee, at least one week prior to the election, shall post conspicuously on the church bulletin board the list of candidates for office.
- g. Nominations shall not be taken from the floor during the meeting of the election.

Reminder: A "voting member" is a confirmed member who has *communed in this congregation <u>and made a contribution of record to this congregation</u> during the current year (2017) or the previous year (2016). <i>All voting members of the congregation are strongly encouraged to attend this meeting.* As members of Christ's Body, the Church, it is not only our *obligation* but our *privilege* to make our voices heard as we prayerfully discern our Lord's plans for the ministry which will be conducted in His name at Bethany. Please plan now to attend this important meeting.
