Dear Friends and Members of Bethany Lutheran Church,

Happy August. Every Sunday at the beginning of worship we try and identify "God Sightings" we have had in the past week. How has God moved you, touched you, nudged you to further God's Kingdom? Well, Bethany Lutheran has experienced an outstanding God Sighting, where God has invited us into a new mission partnership with Dogwood Charter School. Dogwood Charter School is a tuition -free public school funded by taxpayers and open to all students within the Commonwealth. Currently there are 75 students from Bethel Park and Peters Township who have enrolled. Their curriculum consists of "living books, "living" things, and "living" ideas that meet Pennsylvania's state standards.

The Church also is a living organism that communicates the Gospel through relationships. We do this all the time, but now we have been given an opportunity to utilize God's building in an intentional way for children seeking an education. Dogwood Charter offers a curriculum using whole books that are narrative and informational, not just relying on textbooks. Students will read, narrate and converse about "living" ideas that promote analytical thinking and ideas. Much like we do when studying Theology. Real life problems and understanding mathematical concepts will be developed that are meaningful, and understood.

Students have also been invited to participate, share and learn about our ministry with SHIM (South Hills Interfaith Movement) to include hands on experiences.

Dogwoods presence will not hinder Bethany's mission, but only enhance it. They will typically meet in the Fellowship Hall and utilize 5 classrooms Monday – Thursday 8:30- 3:30 and Friday is a half day. All envisioned scenarios have been carefully looked at through the eyes of Attorneys, the school district, Board of Directors and Church Council. There is a lease agreement available on the bulletin board in the Narthex of the church. We will be hosting an Open House inviting neighbors, congregants, representatives in the area and Students and family members to a meet and greet on Thursday August 29<sup>th</sup> from 5-7p.m.

Stay Tuned and Be open and receptive to our incoming God Sightings.

# The SAD news about nutrition

U.S. medical data present a real paradox: Though we spend more on health care than any other developed country, we are very unhealthy – including shorter life expectancy, the highest obesity rate, and high incidence of diabetes, heart disease and hypertension.

The reasons are complex, but many experts point to the unhealthy "Standard American Diet." With lots of processed foods, saturated fats and refined carbohydrates, the SAD causes more deaths per year than smoking, and half of all heart-disease related deaths.

In other words, the food we eat is killing us. The culprits are the fried foods, the French fries, hamburgers, chips, donuts, prepackaged entrees, breakfast cereals, sugary soft drinks, pizza, candy, meat consumption and freezer-case meals.

The cure for SAD is simple: Eat less of the bad stuff and more fresh vegetables and fruit. When God put Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden, they were given all sorts of fruits and veggies to eat (Genesis 1:29). So, as you eat more veggies, you can think of it as the Garden of Eden Diet.

August is the ideal time to load up on veggies. The summer harvest brings all the delightfully nutritious foods to your local farm market and grocery store. How healthy is your diet? To learn more, search online for "standard American Diet" and see what the experts have to say.
