Happy November Family and Friends,

I'm sure you have heard the expression " of mice and men". This is a reference to the best plans of mice and men often go awry. It is a line from the poem To a Mouse by Robert Burns. The full quote is " The best laid plans of mice and men oft go awry...and leave us nothing but grief and pain, For promised joy!"

The poem is about a farmer who accidentally destroys a mouses nest while plowing a field in the fall. The mouse returns to scold the farmer, who apologizes with the line quoted above. The poem conveys that even the most carefully planned plans can turn out differently than expected. The quote inspired John Steinbecks to write his 1937 book "Of mice and men" which is a story about failed dreams.

Unfortunately, such is the case with The Dogwood Charter School which will no longer be utilizing our building to educate students. Due to zoning and safety issues the church is not a viable option. The top three reasons Charter Schools have a difficult time is: 1. Bureaucratic red tape, 2. Difficulty in starting and maintaining a charter school and 3. Funding and Transparency issues. We have experienced firsthand some of these issues. This has been a "learning" experience for us all. I hope and pray Dogwood will find a suitable location to meet the municipality's concerns. And we as the Body of Christ will continue to be "wise as serpents and innocent as doves (Matthew 10:16)



It's a sophisticated yet easy-to-use medical device that can analyze the heart's rhythm and, if necessary, deliver an electrical shock or defibrillation to help the heart re-establish an effective rhythm. If it is ever needed, do not fear, there are voice prompts spoken once the system is activated. Stay tuned for more information/training on this important potentially life saving machine.
